It is time for our annual pilgrimage to the Petersen. When we gather there on March 17, the newest exhibit, *Sculpture in Motion: Masterpieces of Italian Design*, will have barely been open for 3 weeks.

From the grand classics of the 1930s to modern supercars, Italian designers have led the way. Typical of the vehicles on display are the 1947 Pinin Farina Cisitalia Coupe, the first automobile to become part of the collection of New York's Museum of Modern Art. In contrast is the 1970 Lancia Stratos concept car that changed the shape of mid-engined exotic cars to the now-familiar wedge.

These beautiful and inspirational vehicles and more will keep us busy and entertained all morning. Club members and Petersen docents, Norman Silverman and Gene Brown, will be on hand to explain the exhibit and provide insights into the design philosophies that drove the creation of the very special cars we will see this day.

After our exclusive tour, we will pause for our General Meeting and a burger or salad on-site at the Petersen's Johnny Rockets.
