## AUGUST

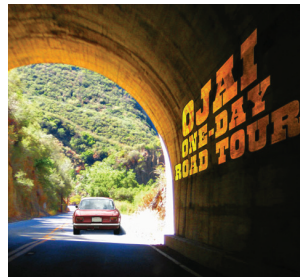
