**1.** We will have a block of rooms at the reliable Laurel Inn, Salinas. Rates are for two nights, three nights or four nights at incredible rates. (See info at the end of this article.)

**2.** AROSC will continue our annual Thursday night pasta fest at the Loose Noodle Pasta House, 538 Lighthouse Ave., Monterey, CA 94940. The prix-fixe menu is \$25 and includes soup, salad; choice of pasta entrees and dessert; tip and tax. There will a minimal charge for tea, coffee, soft drinks, beer and/or wine. Bring cash. As we usually sell out, RSVPs to [norman@msn.com](mailto:norman@msn.com) are required, and as usual we expect a special guest or two.

**3.** West and Maggie Clark will be hosting their annual wine tasting (with a twist). For the first time it will be held on Friday evening starting at 5PM. Instead of the usual light appetizers, a dinner of tri-tip sandwiches, green salad, baked beans and potato salad will be served. Alfa Corral passes are \$25 and are good all three days. (Note: Some ticket options are located below the Corral Parking section.) Add to cart and finish your order.

Laguna Seca will send tickets and passes directly to you, and neither AROSC, ARA nor Delta Sierra will have extra tickets.

**6.** Our upstate Alfa brethren are working on a post-Concorso Saturday night dinner. Watch *Alfacionada* and your mailbox for details.
